VIVIX® exterior weatherboard selected for luxury waterfront homes in Norway



VIVIX® by Formica Group was used as weatherboarding in a neighbourhood of luxury homes in the town of Tromsø in northern Norway.

The neighbourhood lies in an area of outstanding natural beauty along the sound, with the buildings extending out over the water. The architectural firm of Borealis Arkitekter designed the buildings so that all 216 sun-drenched apartments have a view over the sound. They achieved this by carefully placing the buildings and varying their height between four and seven storeys, which also gives the buildings a beautiful profile.

The architects selected VIVIX exterior laminates because they wanted to enhance the buildings with a durable, economical material that also expressed the aesthetic of the area.
